Wardington - A brief history

The name Wardington is believed to originate from the meaning Wearda's farm and first occurs on records c. 1180 but its form suggests that the place was settled in the early Anglo-Saxon period. In 1377 175 people were listed to be living in Wardington. In 1801 the population was 745, and rose to a peak of 865 in 1841, but by 1961 the population was down to 546.

Take the 200 bus from stops in Upper and Lower Wardington.

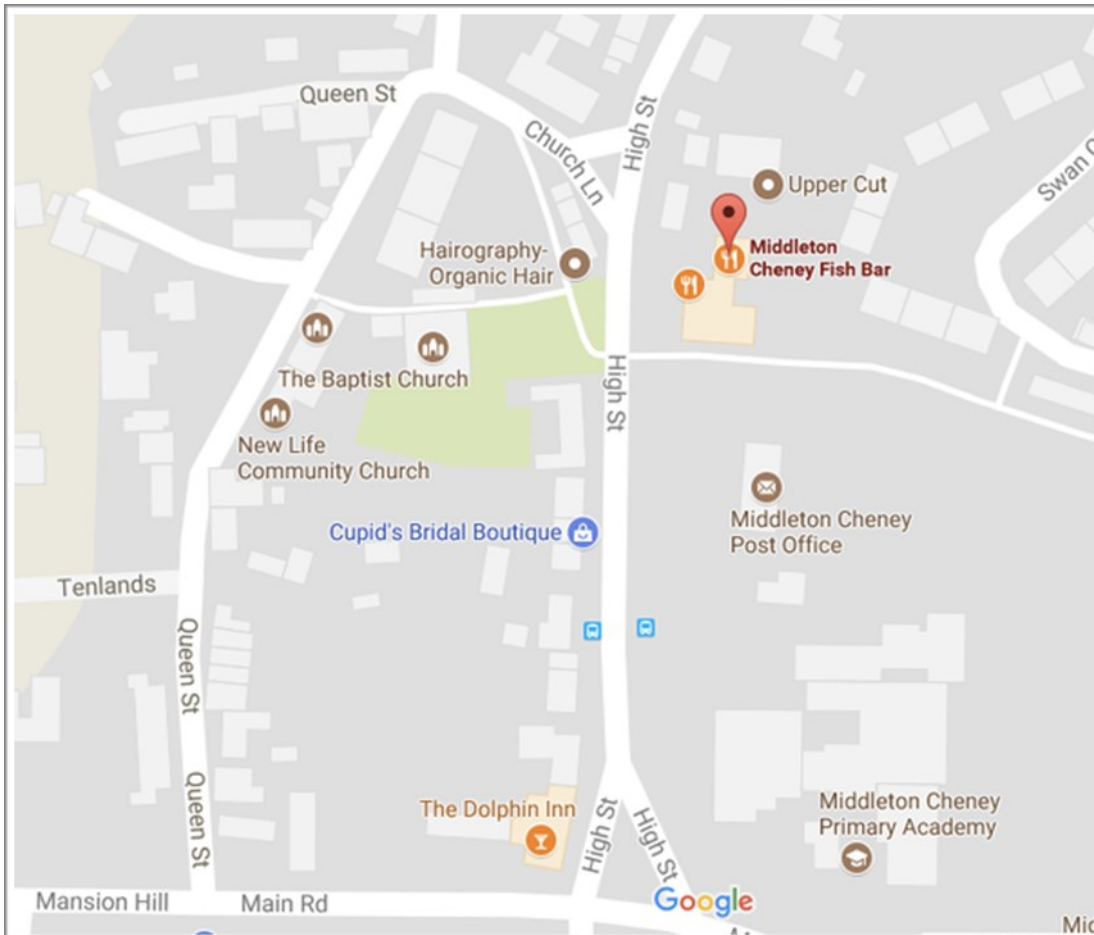

Hungry?

There are a number of takeaways and restaurants in Banbury and the surrounding villages but if you want the closest head to Middleton Cheney for Fish & Chips or an Indian.



Middleton Cheney is just over 3 miles from Wardington and is accessed via Upper Wardington. Head south on the Wardington Road to Chacombe. Turn left when you enter Chacombe and follow the Chacombe Road to the mini roundabout on the edge of Middleton Cheney. Go straight ahead to get to the High St. You can order a delivery from Zinga Spice that is next door to the Fish Bar. Note there is also a **Post Office** in Middleton Cheney.

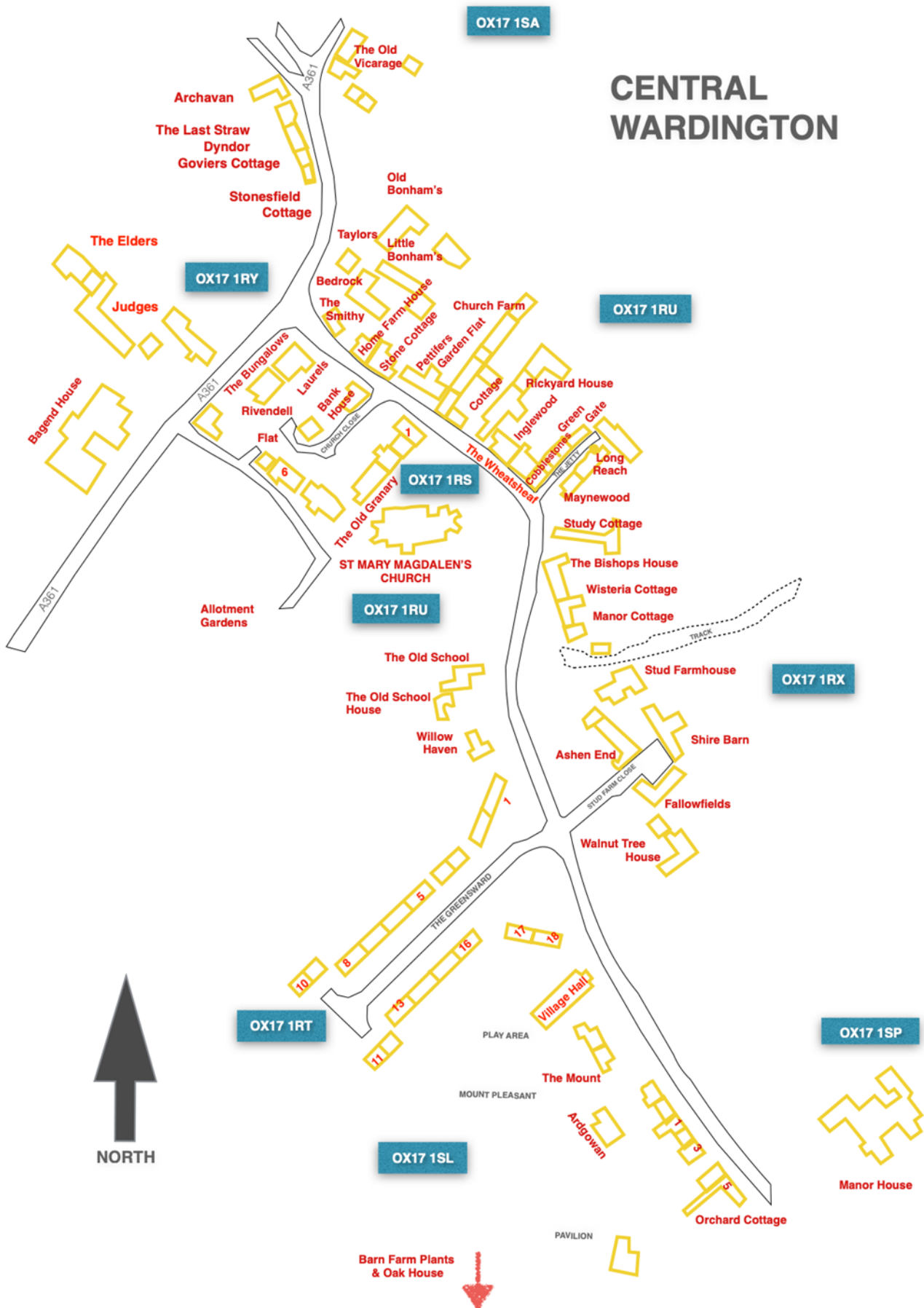

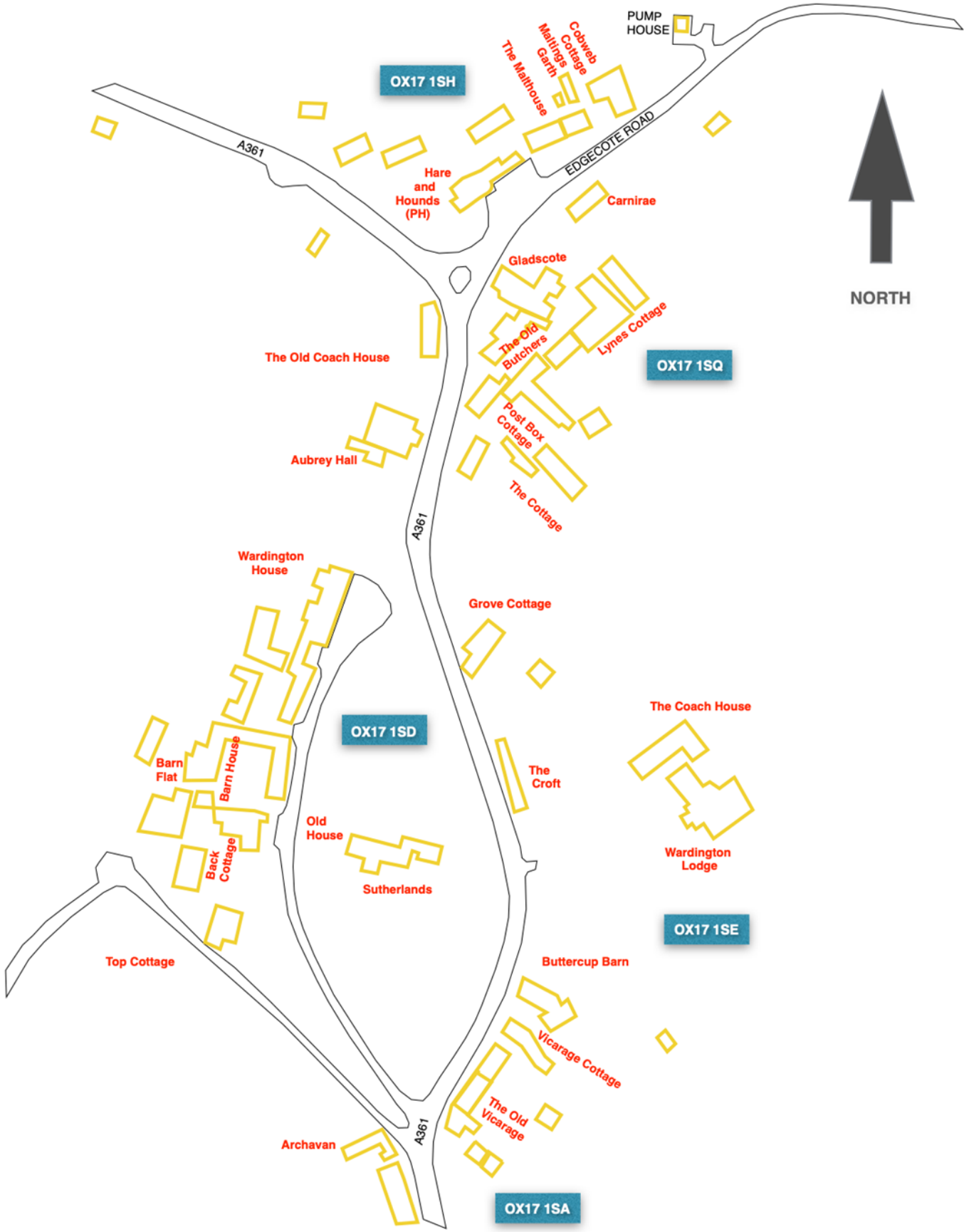
